OU BIG EVENT CELEBRATES 25 YEARS, RETURNS TO PERLE MESTA PARK by JB Schuelein

This Spring the OU Big Event will celebrate 25 years of community service to the greater Oklahoma City metropolitan area. Last year nearly 6,000 OU students and staff representing more than 100 campus organizations volunteered at local non-profit organizations performing a variety of projects including painting, cleaning, planting and any other necessary tasks to further their mission.

Mesta Park has been fortunate to host the Big Event for each of the past 24 years - missing only the inaugural event. When our neighborhood leaders learned of the program, they promptly signed up each year since – enlisting OU's services for our annual Spring clean up in Perle Mesta Park. OU students, faculty and staff members rake leaves, weed flower beds and clean all the curbs and storm drains around the park. It would take our neighborhood Parks Committee weeks to conduct this clean up. But with the assistance of the OU students, we'll collect nearly 50 bags of leaves and sweet gum balls, rake the volleyball courts and remove at least a ton of dirt and accumulated debris from the curbs in a few hours!

We need yard tools – particularly wheelbarrows and shovels. If you can loan them to us for the morning, we'll see that they are returned to you after the event. We also welcome donations of snacks, juice or soft drinks to the students who are giving up their Saturday morning to make the park cleaner and safer for us to enjoy.

Members of our Mainteneers group will supervise teams of students on the various projects. Raina Pelofsky, Cindy Knox, Patty Phelps, Lynette Mathis, Ulises Serrano and Katie Huskerson will be joined by new 'mainteneers' Jim and LaWanda Pickens, Dylan Bergey and Emily Davis. This dedicated group of volunteers have 'adopted' a section of the park to maintain all year.
