OU BIG EVENT 2023 by JB Schuelein

The OU Big Event is a day of community service when OU students and staff volunteer at local non-profit organizations across the entire Oklahoma City metro area. Nearly 6,000 students representing more than 100 campus organizations participated in 2022.

Our neighborhood was fortunate to host nearly 50 young women Saturday morning, April 1, representing a service sorority participating in the Big Event. The group spent their morning in Perle Mesta Park, where they raked leaves, cleaned flower beds, and cleaned all the curbs and storm drains. It would take our neighborhood Parks Committee weeks to conduct this clean up. But with the assistance of the OU students, we collected nearly 50 bags of leaves, raked the volleyball courts and removed at least a ton of dirt and accumulated debris from the curbs in a few hours!

Mesta Park has participated in this program since it was established by OU nearly 20 years ago. The students worked tirelessly giving up their Saturday morning to make our neighborhood park cleaner and safer. Mesta Park sincerely appreciates OU and the Big Event. We can't thank you enough!

A special thanks is also appropriate for several members of our Mainteneers group who supervised the teams of students on the various projects. Raina Pelofsky, Patty Phelps, Lynette Mathis and Bonnie Rennels worked as hard as the students on the Spring Clean-Up. Their year-round efforts have taken our park to another level – and they're not finished yet! Visitors to the park will notice the extra attention to the sidewalks and flower beds. Watch for new additions to the flower beds over the next few weeks as Spring flowering bulbs fade and Summer perennials begin to blossom – as part of our initiative to attract and support pollinators. This program was initiated by Mainteneer Katie Huskerson. Thanks to this dedicated team of our neighbors who give unselfishly so we can all enjoy our neighborhood park.
