

HNSA Security Patrol Fact Sheet

What:

Historic Neighborhoods Security Association (HNSA) was organized in 2007 to deliver security patrols. We have set up a system that uses current and former Oklahoma City Police officers to patrol our neighborhoods. Expect to see the car on the perimeter of our area as well as patrolling neighborhood streets.

Where:

Heritage Hills, Heritage Hills East, and Mesta Park are part of the security patrol arrangement for our area. We also have local businesses and non-residential partners that border our neighborhoods.

Who:

Current and former Oklahoma City Police officers are working for us. They patrol the neighborhoods when not on duty with the Police Department.

The officers are:

1. Uniformed. Retired officers wear a security officer uniform, current officers wear their police uniform.
2. Armed, and carrying radios.
3. Patrolling in a marked HNSA vehicle

Why:

Several members of our communities worked together for over a year investigating, discussing, and brainstorming best practices for neighborhood security. A complete evaluation was conducted and presented at different neighborhood board meetings.

How:

- For help with Suspicious Activity
 - **First: Call 911** If you have any concerns or need immediate help with suspicious activity. This is to ensure that the city can track activity in our neighborhoods properly. Your call to 911 facilitates this record keeping.
 - **Second:** Call the patrol officer at (405) 640-0324.

When the officer is not on another call and patrolling, they will answer and respond as soon as possible.

- To schedule a house or vehicle check
 - **Call Either**
 - The Administrative Service at (405) 348-1346
 - The patrol officer on duty at (405) 640-0324

They will provide you with a form to complete and will place your house on the schedule for service.

Please note: During the major holidays the service is popular, so calling and scheduling early is appreciated.
